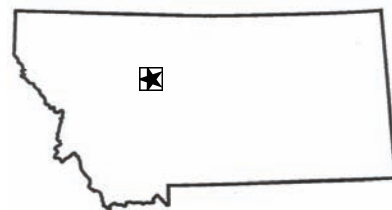
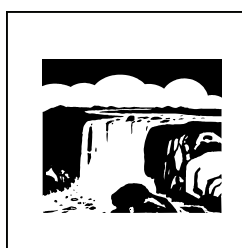

MEETINGS. Monthly general meetings are held the second Thursday of each month, September through June, at 7:00 p.m. Guests and visitors are always welcome.

QUERIES. Queries are printed at no charge to members and five cents a word for non-members. Queries should be written out in full. All surnames should be capitalized. Use full names, dates and places where known. Full names and complete dates equal one word.

GENEALOGY LIBRARY. The Genealogy Library is located on the third floor of the Great Falls Public Library. The library is staffed entirely by volunteers. Hours are Monday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m..

RESEARCH POLICY. Our volunteer research staff is available to do research on Cascade County and Great Falls records. Research will commence upon receipt of the fees; check or money order may be sent to our Great Falls address. There are three research options:

-Option 1: a comprehensive search of the records at the Great Falls Genealogy Society library. A member of the Research Department staff will search appropriate obit/death card file index, local history books, Great Falls city directories, Cascade County directories, people files and some early birth indices for which the fee is \$20 per immediate family.

-Option 2: includes a thorough search of the records at the Cascade County Courthouse including school census indices, probate indices, marriage indices, civil judgment indices (includes divorce filings), naturalization indices and voter registrations from 1887-1910 for which the fee is \$20 per immediate family.

-Option 3: includes five research activities chosen from option one and two for a fee of \$20 per immediate family.

Photocopies of obituaries, marriage license/certificates and birth and death certificates are \$5 each if ordered separately, \$3 each if ordered with option 1, 2 or 3 (Note: Photocopies of birth and death certificates less than 30 years old can be obtained only by the mother, father, spouse or child of the individual of whom the record is requested).

“Kelly-on-the-Trail Again. Well Known Character [George Kelly] Indulges in Another Periodical Spree--Police Court Docket.

George Kelly, better known as ‘Kelly-on-the-Trail,’ came up smiling in police court this morning and renewed his acquaintance with Hizzoner Hanley. It has been several weeks since Kelly was last in Great Falls and in the meantime he has been looking after the interests of a band of sheep up in Chouteau County for Neil Bannatyne. As the Chouteau County authorities need him as a witness in another case, the court discharged the prisoner.

‘The next time you come to town you might as well come to the station yourself and save the police the trouble for bringing you,’ said Chief of Police Pontet to Kelly, as he took his departure. Kelly answered that he guessed he would, as he smiled broadly in appreciation of the joke.”

During my recent trip to the Spencer County Library in Rockport, Indiana to do some genealogy research, I discovered a copy of a letter from Nathaniel Wilson to his children, written 18 May 1862.

A widower with three children, Nathaniel, 41, enlisted in the Union army 16 October 1861, as a private in Capt. Medcalf's Company, 42nd Regiment Indiana Infantry (this organization subsequently became Co. B, 42nd Regiment Indiana Infantry). He became ill and was hospitalized in Fayetteville, Tennessee, where he wrote this letter.

Nathaniel's sister, Mary Wilson Larkin, is my great-great-great grandmother. In the letter, Nathaniel mentions William Larkin, Mary's son and my great-great grandfather.

What follows is a verbatim transcription of Nathaniel's letter.

18th 1862
Fayttville May

My dear children

I once more take the opportunity of writing a few lines to you. I am still terrible sick yet at the hospital in Fayetteville and to tell the truth almost worse then better. As I do not know wether I ever will see you again I think it is of importance to you to know your ages. Nelson was born July 21, 1845. George Washington was born July 26, 1847. Sarah Luise was born 10 of November 1859.

Be [*letter torn*]ghty carefull to recollect your ages and do not ferget them because it is of importance to you to know how old your are.

I have been praying for and I prayed for you last with all my heart that the lord might be with you and bless you.

I must give you one exhortation yet go to meeting and keep out of bad company and try to pray. Remember and do everything as I have told so as you can meet your dear mother in heaven and I am confident you will do so. I am not able to help myself and I do not know when I will be able to help myself again.

uncle Hiram is staying with me and will do so as long as the captain lets him. And if we leave here I will try to stay with him. William Larkins can keep the place on the same terms and pay the rent as fast as he can. I want him to pay my debts from the rent as fast as he can.

I must come to close for the present and remain your affectionate father untill death.

Nathanael Wilson
My best respects to all my friends.

Nathaniel Wilson died the day after this letter was written, 19 May 1862. He is buried at the Stones River National Cemetery, Murfreesboro, Tennessee.
