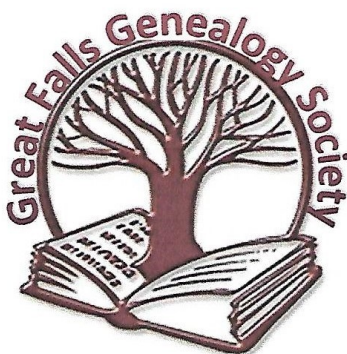

Researchers will complete a comprehensive search of the records available at the Great Falls Genealogy Society library.

Any additional search of local records readily available at the Cascade County Courthouse *requires an additional fee and additional time.* Other fees may apply if the request is extensive.

First Church of the Nazarene, Great Falls, Montana
Rev. Larry D. Spicer

In 1941 Lyle Krueger, a young minister with the Church of the Nazarene, came to Great Falls to work for the Federal Housing Project on the construction of Parkdale. Not finding a Nazarene congregation in the city, Rev. Krueger arranged for evangelist Maurice Gordon of Dawson, Minnesota to come hold meetings.

On the closing night of Rev. Gordon's revival, Rev. Krueger called for those interested in the forming a church to remain. A few stayed after the service and at that time a Prayer Band was organized. Rev. Krueger was appointed leader and Nora Space secretary. Consisting of less than ten people, this band met weekly in various homes.

During one of these meetings it was suggested another evangelist be called. This was done, with the evangelistic services being held in April of 1942. Near the conclusion of these meetings, District Superintendent Eckels came from Billings. On the last night of the meetings, in May 1942, Rev. Eckels organized the First Church of the Nazarene in Great Falls, Montana. Pledges of \$15.00 monthly were guaranteed for a pastor's salary.

Those signing their names as charter members of the church were Rev. Lyle Krueger, Mrs. Krueger, Mr. Bert Taule, Mrs. Taule, Bert Taule Jr., Mrs. Opal Schultz and sons, Harry and Bill, Mrs. Alice Barrow, and Phyllis Morgan. This faithful group of ten formed the nucleus and set the spirit of what the church is today.

The Church of the Nazarene initially rented 1408 2nd Avenue N, a facility owned by Our Savior's Lutheran Church. On October 5, 1941 they held their first services at 416 13th Street N, the former North Side Fire Station that they purchased from the city and renovated. In June 1955 the congregation moved to its present location at 1727 2nd Avenue S. The church that was built there has been expanded three times and undergone major renovations. The current pastor is Rev. Jeffrey Lauver, who became part of the congregation when he was a junior in high school.

While preparing for the 75th Anniversary of the church the following Sunday School records were discovered.

December 23, 1900 the Great Falls Tribune (GFT) reported on page 5 construction had started on the Catholic Church estimating to cost \$35,000. An addition to the First Methodist Church's was estimated to cost \$25,000. The Presbyterians were preparing to build a new church estimated to cost \$25,000. The Swedish Baptist Church will cost several thousand dollars.

May 19, 1906 the GFT reported on page 6 construction had started that day on the local Church of Christ building in Boston Heights. The building was estimated to take 30 days to complete. The 36 x 50 building was constructed on a site donated by the Boston and Great Falls Land Co. It would cost about \$3,200.

December 10, 1923 the GFT reported on page 9 \$16,000 had been raised to finance a new United Brethren Church that was estimated to cost \$30,000 total. The church was to built at 16th Street and Central.

June 4, 1927 the GFT reported on page 6 bids would be opened on June 30 for the construction of a new St. John's English Lutheran church at 4th Avenue North and 13th Street. The estimated cost was \$50,000.

July 14, 1927 the GFT reported on page 9 the cornerstone of the new Baptist Church at 2nd Avenue North and 6th Street had been laid. The building would cost \$50,000 and was the first unit of an edifice that would be completed at a total cost of \$150,000.

September 5, 1927 the GFT reported on page 9 construction for a new Christian Church estimating to cost \$54,000 was starting that week. The church would be located at the corner of 11th Street and Central Avenue. The First Christian Church was established in the spring of 1903 in Great Falls. In 1915 they moved from the Boston Heights church to the corner of 9th and 3rd Avenue N. The Boston Heights building was sold to the Methodist congregation who planned to remodel it to be a chapel of the mission style.

September 7, 1929 the GFT reported on page 6 construction will start on a new Trinity Lutheran Church estimating to cost \$15,000. The 31 x 63 structure would be located at 1226 1st Avenue North.
